**Woman** You're welcome.

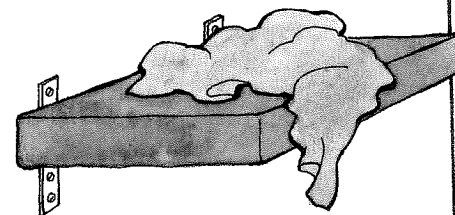
Lee's family buys some shirts and leaves the clothes shop.

**Lee** Can't we have fish and chips instead?



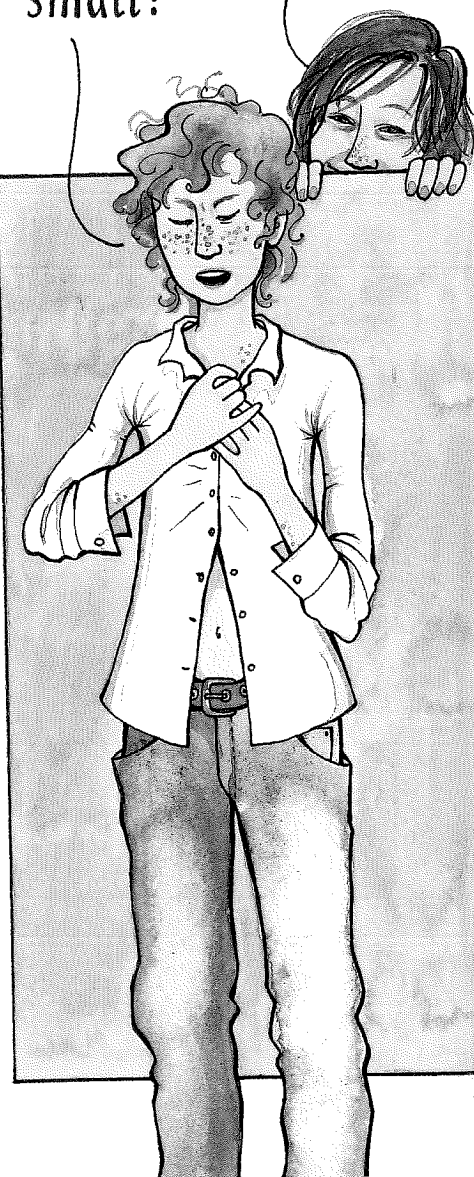
town – stad
